The photo at the top shows an aerial view of the Gladewater High school building facilities, including the gymnasium at far left. The high school facilities include one large building which houses classrooms, a girls' gymnasium, activities room, auditorium, administrative offices, printing and journalism departments and numerous other facilities. Located in separate buildings are the cafeteria, vocational agriculture department, fine arts department and the boys' gymnasium. This picture shows the high school from the back side and the football stadium and field to the right.

The Gladewater Municipal building is one of the most modern buildings in the city and houses a number of city offices, including those for the mayor, city manager, water and sewer departments, fire department, city secretary, and the police department and city jail. The jail, an auditorium, offices and the fire boys' dormitory are located upstairs.

Owned and operated by the city, the Gladewater Municipal hospital provides facilities to care for 43 patients at a time in private and semi-private rooms. The hospital is air conditioned and centrally heated and is one of the most modern hospitals operated by a city in this area.

These are only a few of the buildings of which Gladewater is proud—others include the Community Center building, the post office, other school plants, the many impressive church buildings, and numerous business houses.
