### Three Hospitals, Two Clinics Serving City Of Gladewater

The city of Gladewater, with a population of 1,211, can boast of three modern hospitals and two additional specialized clinics. The hospitals are Gladewater Municipal, Leake clinic-hospital and Hancock clinic-hospital. The two clinics are McKean clinic and Bloom clinic.

The Municipal hospital is completely equipped with the most modern equipment and is adequate for all kinds of surgery. The hospital is owned and operated by the city of Gladewater which employs Mrs. J. C. McKean as general manager, Dr. Carl Nichols as chief of staff.

Dr. J. C. McKean is the builder of this hospital and it was built in 1928 and he said it is the city's finest. The building is a two-story structure and accommodates 17 patients.

Leake hospital and clinic, which is owned and operated by Dr. H. A. Leake, was opened in May of 1932. The building was built in 1918 as a hotel structure. It is an all-steel construction and is air-conditioned throughout.

A two-story building, the downtown

and the entire building is air-conditioned and the interior decorations are modern and very attractive.

Located upstairs in the operating room, central drug storage room, x-ray, delivery room and morgue with a total of 25 beds. The operating rooms is furnished with new and complete equipment in all respects.

Most of the rooms for patients are equipped with individual laboratory and they are all furnished with comfortable chairs, dressing tables and bed tables.

Dr. Leake has purchased additional beds on which he plans to expand and enlarge his hospital.

Hancock hospital and clinic is owned and operated by Dr. A. H. Hancock. For 30 patients and 10 beds it was built in 1934 as a two-story building.

The building also houses a three room nurse quarters upstairs.
