## REQUEST FOR HEARING FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT Tex. Rules of Court 503.1

**Instructions:** A plaintiff who seeks a default judgment against a defendant **must** request a hearing, orally or in writing. The plaintiff must appear at the hearing and provide evidence of damages. If the plaintiff proves its damages, the judge must render judgment for the plaintiff in the amount proven. If the plaintiff is unable to prove its damages, the judge must render judgment in favor of the defendant.

The plaintiff requesting a default judgment must provide to the clerk in writing a certificate of last known mailing address of the defendant(s) at or before the time the judgment is signed.
