 Standard Terms & Conditions. Section 22 of Exhibit B (Standard Terms and Conditions) is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

Notwithstanding anything in this Agreement to the contrary, Gregg County reserves the right to terminate an agreement/contract at any time, without cause, upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Respondent. Upon termination, Gregg County shall pay Respondent for those costs directly attributable to work done including the work to deploy the Conterra-owned infrastructure, and supplies obtained in preparation for completion or compliance with the Contract, except no payment shall be made for costs recoverable by Respondent in the normal course of doing business or which can be mitigated through the sale of supplies or materials obtained for use under this Contract. It is further agreed by Respondent that Gregg County shall not be liable for loss or reduction in any anticipated profit.

2. Other than the addition set forth above, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect. In the event of any conflict between the terms and conditions of this Addendum and the terms and conditions of the Agreement, this Addendum shall prevail.
