CONVENTIONAL DESIGN (FEE: \$210.00)

□ Obtain an **Application** from GCHD

<u>Minimum</u> lot size: ½ <u>acre</u> with community water, or <u>1 acre</u> with water well. (Contact GCHD office concerning lots that do not meet above criteria, but were platted prior to January 1, 1988).

	Have a <u>Site Evaluation (soil classification and design plan)</u> performed by a <u>Registered Sanitarian</u> or <u>Professional Engineer</u> . Your designer must complete the <u>Technical Information Sheet.</u>
	Submit <u>Application</u> , <u>Technical Information Sheet</u> (in property owner's name) and <u>Acknowledgement of OSSF maintenance</u> and <u>management practices of water conservation measures</u> along with all other related documents for review.
	Submit the <u>Fee</u> and one copy of each of the following: <u>Site Evaluation Results</u> and <u>Diagram of System</u> .
	<u>Application</u> and <u>Plans</u> will be reviewed by GCHD.
	Upon approval, <u>Authorization</u> will be issued to begin construction.
	Begin construction*. An <u>Inspection</u> of the installation is required <u>Before</u> covering of the system. Contact our office at least <u>1</u> <u>Working Day</u> in advance to arrange an inspection.
	After a successful inspection, a Notice of Approval will be issued to the owner.

	<u>Irregular</u> and/or <u>undersized lots</u> , substantial <u>variances</u> to the " <u>Construction Standards</u> ", unconventional design, or innovative systems you must submit <u>Appropriate</u> supporting documents. For " <u>Aerobic Systems</u> ", an <u>Affidavit to the Public</u> and a <u>Maintenance Agreement</u> must be submitted.
	Obtain an Application from GCHD.
	Hire a Registered Sanitarian or Professional Engineer to perform a Site Evaluation and Design the System .
	Submit the <u>Application</u> , <u>Technical Information Sheet</u> (in owner's name) and Acknowledgement of OSSF maintenance and management practices of water conservation measures along with all other related documents for review.
	Submit the <u>Fee</u> and one copy of each of the following: <u>Complete Design Plans</u> (including checklist, site evaluation results and system design).
	<u>Application</u> and <u>Plans</u> will be reviewed by GCHD.
	Upon approval, <u>Authorization</u> will be issued to begin construction.
	Begin construction*. An <u>Inspection</u> of the installation is required <u>Before</u> covering of the system. Contact our office at least <u>1</u> <u>Working Day</u> in advance to arrange an inspection.
	After a successful inspection, a Notice of Approval will be issued to the owner.

*If a person other than the system owner does construction, that person must hold a valid Texas Installer Certificate
